FAST AND ABSTINANCE. All Fridays of Lent are universal days of fast and abstinence.

Abstinence: All Catholics 14 and older (no age limit) are to abstain from eating meat (no meat) on all Fridays of Lent.

Fasting: All Catholics 21-59 are to *limit the amount of food they eat.* Only one full meal, and two smaller meals that together do not equal a full meal, are eaten. The best rule of thumb is to make sure your meals are smaller than what you would eat on a normal day - and to avoid snacks.

Exemption is allowed for pregnant women and those who need regular meals for medical reasons.
